Her parents didn't quite know what to expect from "Conductive Education rehabilitation" so originally their only goal

was to increase her mobility. They quickly realized that she would be improving more than just her mobility – she would be gaining independence! Her core strength has improved, her weaker hand has strengthened, and she's gone from barely crawling to walking assisted in a walker. And she's making progress eating independently and being potty trained – things her parents did not expect!

As for her future goals, every day brings her closer to walking independently! Until then, she's happy and proud of each and every achievement, and we celebrate them with her and her family!
