

Conductive Education Assistant (CEA) Position Open

Part-time, \$13.50 per hour, Tuesdays from 9 AM – 4 PM starting as soon as possible until June 13th, 2017 with the potential of a full-time summer position after this position ends.

Preference will be given to university students studying in a field similar to Conductive Education Rehabilitation (Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Kinesiology, etc).

The Movement Centre of Manitoba provides Conductive Education Rehabilitation to help children and adults of all ages with movement disabilities such as cerebral palsy, multiple sclerosis, stroke, acquired brain injury, Parkinson's disease, spina-bifida, developmental delays, etc.

Requirements:

Candidates must speak English, have a clear criminal record check (must be provided upon gaining employment), and be clear in the adult/child abuse registry.

Duties:

CEA's assist our Conductors in our programs. They are 1-1 with our clients during our programs. CEA's help set up our programs and clean up after programs. Other related tasks are included.

- Have some experience working or volunteering in the disabled community
- The ability to motivate in a positive manner
- Strong comprehension of English, both written and spoken
- Creative and expressive in a group environment
